

State Historical Society of North Dakota Heritage Profile Honor Award

Guidelines

I. Award Objective

The Heritage Profile Honor Award is given in recognition of those individuals who have made a lasting or significant contribution in preserving, interpreting, promoting, researching and/or otherwise extending the knowledge and understanding of the history of North Dakota. Individuals to be recognized include those living or deceased who have demonstrated evidence of long-term dedication and personal commitment in pursuit of the above goals.

II. Award Nominations

- A. Nominations may be developed by state officials, legislators, county and local officials, members of the State Historical Board, historical organizations, other associations, or private citizens residing in North Dakota.
- B. Nominations may be submitted to the Communications and Education Division of the State Historical Society of North Dakota. A special committee will select the award recipient.
- C. Nominations may not be made by any individual on behalf of themselves.
- D. Nominations must be accompanied by a resumé of not more than 250 words that cites the contributions of the nominee related to the award's objective.

III. Award Nomination Schedule

Nominations may be made for committee consideration by September 17 to be eligible for the award to be given in the fall.

IV. Award Recognition

The observance and presentation of the award will be made at the State Historical Society of North Dakota Foundation's annual meeting.
