The information found in the 1925 bound volumes distinguishes registration for Ford vehicles and non-Ford vehicles. Trucks and motorcycles ate registered in a separate log. Information from the ledgers include: register number, date, owner and post office, county, manufacturer, serial or model number, number of cylinders, the registration fee, any changes in registration, and new owner. The registration volumes include manufacturers' makes and models.
