Aviation

The first recorded aeronautical event in North Dakota took place on July 19, 1910. Thereafter, airplanes and aviation would permeate the state's history, including through entertainment, transportation, and education. This pathfinder will lead researchers to several resources available at the North Dakota State Archives highlighting the accomplishments of North Dakota's aviation history.

Archival Collections

10052 Carl Ben Eielson Papers

Scholarship application, examination papers, airline records, posthumous memorials, postal covers, documents, correspondence, awards and published materials. The airline records include schedules, agreements, reports, and correspondence from the Farthest-North Airplane Company and the Alaskan Air Transport Corporation. The documents date from 1926 to 1929 and consist of pilot's licenses, a passport, and membership card. The correspondence dates from 1925 to 1930 and consists of personal letters from Eielson to Joe Snowfield, recommendation letters from military personnel, arctic exploration congratulatory letters and telegrams, and letters to Ole Eielson concerning his son, Carl Ben. He had been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor, Distinguished Flying Cross, and the Harmon Trophy.

10071 Erling Nicolai Rolfsrud Papers

Correspondence concerning research for a book, Arsenic and Biscuits, two book galley proofs, drafts, and a typescript for a book on Carl Ben Eielson entitled "Ben Eielson, An Appreciation" published as "Brother to the Eagle" by Sir Hubert Wilkins (Rolfsrud's pen name).

10109 Richard Virgil Grace Papers

Correspondence, literary manuscripts, scrapbooks, notes, newspaper clippings, and photographs. Papers relate to Grace's service in the world wars and his film and stunt flying career.
