Livestock production is a large part of North Dakota's economy. This pathfinder will lead researchers to several resources available at the North Dakota State Archives highlighting the importance of livestock production in North Dakota.

Archival Collections

10036 Antoine Amedee Marie Vincent Manca de Vallombrosa, Marquis de Mores Collection

Family and business papers and miscellany. Family and business papers consist of correspondence, financial records, a scrapbook, language exercise notebooks, Marguis de Mores and Company records, and murder trial records. Correspondence Reports from the Pinkerton Detective Agency concerning investigation of suspected cattle and horse rustlers, safe passage letter through Indian reservations, telegrams, last wishes of the Marquis, and a letter to Gov. Gilbert A. Pierce concerning Standing Rock Sioux documents. Correspondents include Daniel Collins, Henry H. Gorringe, and Frank O'Donald. Financial records include household receipts, receipt book for Vallombrosa estate, expense books, account books, and a check book. Scrapbook contains clippings on the Marquis' activities while in Dakota kept by his wife, Medora. The Marquis de Mores and Company records, 1886-1887, consist of share certificates, certificate of organization, production tables, and a report on beef feeding presented to the Montana Stockgrowers' Association. The Reilly Luffsey murder trial records date from 1885 and consist of a court petition, trial transcript, and court docket entries. Miscellany includes manuscripts, French language periodicals, ephemera, and newspapers. Manuscripts consist of two translations of Charles Droulers' The Marquis de Mores, 1858-1896, by George F. Will and M.N. Hagen. The periodicals contain articles regarding the life of the Marquis and ephemera of household goods leaflets, catalogs, a brand book, and travel brochures. Newspapers include German issues and two French newspapers from the Chateau de Mores in Medora.

10157 North Dakota Oral History Project Records

Oral history interview transcripts, indexes to recorded oral history interviews, interview referral files, interview files, photographs, lists of donations to the Project, oral history interview transcripts relating to the Governor's Mansion, family histories, biographies, reminiscences, and manuscripts. Most of the records document administration of the Project. Genealogical information and oral history interview (Continued on next page)

10477 Jamestown (N.D.) Chamber of Commerce Records

Minutes, subject files, committee files, memos, budgets, reports, audits, financial statements, photographs and negatives, scrapbooks, promotional material, by-laws, memorabilia, publications, records from the ND Goes Wild project (wildflower project), issues of the Credit Bulletin, 35 mm slides, posters, and programs. Records relate primarily to administration of the Chamber, promotional activities, tourism, community celebrations, area businesses, economic and industrial development, Garrison Dam, and the North Dakota Dairy Show.

10740 Dairy Women of North Dakota Records

Organizational records and scrapbooks. Records consist of bylaws and minutes, correspondence, annual promotion reports, "REAL" Dairy News and other newsletters, letterhead and an envelope, a membership brochure, and information about publicity chair duties. Scrapbooks contain organization reports, newspaper clippings, photographs, and material promoting the dairy industry.

Minutes of the organization.

10993 Don Levingston Short Papers

Files relating to the legislative activities of the 86th, 87th, and 88th Congress. Includes correspondence with constituents and other legislators, newspaper clippings, copies of bills, and the Congressional Record. Some folders address bills written by Short or other members of the North Dakota delegation and others deal with congressional committees and federal offices.

11091 Gessner Dairy Records

Collection consists of family photographs, photographs of cattle, genealogical information, a telephone directory and railroad material from Penn (ND), a yield chart, and publication.

11178 North Dakota Dairy Coalition Records

Records of the ND Dairy Coalition, which include bylaws, annual meeting minutes and convention programs, board meeting minutes, minutes of the Fundraising Committee, correspondence, map of ND dairy producers, progress report, list of contributors, a study about the economic impact of the dairy industry on North Dakota, results from a survey of dairies in North Dakota, a presentation from the 2005 convention and organizational history (on CDs), convention awards, Dairy Princess photo, publications, promotional material and agreements. The collection also includes records of the Livestock Alliance (NDSU) and Milk Producers Association of North Dakota, results from a Dairy Task Force Survey for the North Dakota Dairy Coalition, programs and printed material, and meeting minutes of the ND Dairy Coalition fundraising committee. The North Dakota Dairy Coalition was incorporated in 2004 and represents dairy producers, industry representatives and government entities that are working to increase the number of dairy cows in North Dakota.

Consists of microfilmed material relating to North Dakota's agriculture and rural life prior to 1946.

The files occupy 2.5 cubic feet and consist of manuscript drafts of the North Dakota segment of the history of grazing, biographies and reminiscences of ranchers in North Dakota (providing information concerning ranches, locations, size of herds, extent of grazing lands, ranching activities and operations, grazing associations, summer grazing, beef and sheep ranchers, cattle driving, marketing, relations with homesteaders, rustlers, vigilantes, cattle barons, conflicts with Indians, and early ranching stories), notes, maps, newspaper clippings, correspondence, bibliographies, and indexes.

This series consists of minutes that document administration of the agency; regulation of public utilities, motor carriers, grain elevators, livestock dealers, and warehouses; inspections; and licensing. The minutes provide data on rates and tariff charges, railroad and highway right-of-way issues, construction of utilities, lease agreements, bills approved, hearings before the Commission, complaints from the public, classification of carriers, permits issued, investigations, and salary approval.

Also contains the annual filing with USDA of the "Application for Initial or Continued Qualification of State or Regional Dairy Product Promotion Research, or Nutrition Education Program" and related correspondence. documents administration of the Commission and the Commission's efforts to promote consumption of dairy products.
